Approving bond of Richard R. Price as Justice of the Peace of Bexley Township.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. THAT, WHEREAS, Richard R. Price who was on the 8th day of November, 1949, duly elected Justice of the Peace of Bexley Township for the term of four years commencing on the 1st day of January, 1950, has presented his bond for the faithful performance of his duties as such Justice of the Peace in the penal sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) conditioned for the faithful performance of his duties as such Justice of the Peace as required by statute, with United States Fidelity and Guaranty Company, Baltimore, Maryland, surety thereon, and said bond appearing to be in all respects in accordance with the statutes, the same is hereby approved and the Clerk of Council is authorized to enter said approval thereon.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
