

ORDINANCE NO. 9-51

To prohibit parking on the south side of the driveway from Parkview Avenue to the house in Jeffrey Park.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. No person shall stand or park a motor vehicle on, along, or adjacent to the south side of the driveway leading from Parkview Avenue to the building located in the park, commonly known as Jeffrey Park, in the City of Bexley, unless in compliance with the direction of a police officer, or a traffic control device. This prohibition shall not apply to such vehicles as may be engaged in delivering merchandise or other articles to said building.

Section 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized to place and maintain such traffic control devices upon said driveway, as he may deem necessary to indicate and carry out the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 3. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$50.00, together with the costs of prosecution.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
