

ORDINANCE NO. 19 -51

Providing for the construction of a water main in Livingston Avenue from Sheridan Avenue to Mayfield Place, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That it is necessary to construct, and there shall be constructed, an eight inch water main in Livingston Avenue from and connecting with the existing eight inch stub at Sheridan Avenue, and extending to Mayfield Place, said main being necessary for a proper supply of water to the abutting properties for domestic use and sanitary purposes, in accordance with the plans, profiles, estimates and specifications hereinafter prepared by the engineers and on file in the Office of the Mayor. That the Mayor and Auditor are authorized to enter into a contract therefor after advertisement according to law.

Section 2. That there be and hereby is appropriated from the Water Fund the sum of \$4,100.00 to pay for the cost and expense of said improvement hereinabove provided.

Section 3. That there be and hereby is fixed as a proper charge for each connection into said water main, which shall be made by the owners of properties bounding and abutting upon said improvement, the sum of \$ 150.00 for each such connection, which amount shall be paid by the owners of the said abutting properties in addition to the cost of making the tap, the same to be paid to the City at the time of making of such connection. Said amount so made for said connections to be deposited to the credit of the Water Fund for its reimbursement for the cost of said improvement.

Section 4. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the properties abutting upon said improvement are without any adequate supply of water for domestic, sanitary and business purposes, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
