

RESOLUTION NO. 5-52

To amend Section 2 of Resolution No. 1-52, providing for lighting the streets and parts of streets in the City of Bexley.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 2 of Resolution No. 1-52 to provide for the lighting of the streets and parts of streets in the City of Bexley therein named, passed January 22, 1952, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. That the whole cost of said improvement, less 19 per cent thereof, which 19 per cent is in excess of 1/50th of said cost and the cost of intersections, shall be assessed in proportion to the benefits which may result from the improvement upon all the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon the proposed improvement, which said lots and lands are hereby determined to be specially benefitted by said improvement; and the cost of said improvement shall include the expense of the preliminary and other surveys and of printing and publishing the notices, resolutions and ordinances required, and the serving of said notices, the cost of construction together with interest on notes and bonds issued in anticipation of the collection of deferred assessments, and all other necessary expenditures."

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
