

ORDINANCE NO. 10-54

Providing for modification of salaries of certain appointive officials and employees and declaring an emergency.

Whereas, by reason of the present economic conditions Council deems it expedient and proper to provide for an increase in salaries of certain appointive officials and employees of the City hereinafter specifically set forth, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That from and after April 1st, 1954, and until further action of Council, the salaries of the following appointive officials and employees shall be as follows per month, payable semi-monthly:

- (a) Director of Recreation - June, July, August \$387.00  
Director of Recreation (Other 9 months of year) \$193.50
- (b) Secretary of the Board (Part Time) \$167.62
- (c) Custodian of Jeffrey Property \$292.33

Section 2. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary in the daily operations of the various departments of the City government for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the city and shall be in full force and effect from and after the first day of April, 1954.
