

RESOLUTION NO. 3-56

To transfer excess money not necessary for the operation of the Water Fund from the Water Fund to the General Fund.

Whereas, this Council on the 26th day of July 1955, duly passed Ordinance No. 17-55 providing for the submission to the electors of the City of Bexley at the November 8, 1955, election, the question of amending the Charter of the City of Bexley to permit the transfer of excess money not necessary for the operation of the Water Fund from the Water Fund to the General Fund, and

Whereas, at the election held November 8, 1955, said amendment was duly approved by the voters of the City of Bexley, Ohio, and it is now the desire of Council, with the approval of the Mayor and Auditor, to transfer part of the excess money not necessary for the operation of the Water Fund from the Water Fund to the General Fund, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Auditor, shall, as soon as possible, transfer \$50,000.00 from the Water Fund to the General Fund in accordance with the provisions of Section 28A of the Charter of the City of Bexley, Ohio, said sum of \$50,000.00 being excess money not necessary for the operation of the Water Fund.
