

ORDINANCE NO. 14-56

By Mr. Bell

To prohibit certain acts with regard to operator's and chauffeur's licenses.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. No person shall:

- (A) Display, or cause or permit to be displayed, or possess any operator's or chauffeur's license knowing the same to be fictitious, or to have been canceled, revoked, suspended, or altered;
- (B) Lend to a person not entitled thereto, or knowingly permit him to use any operator's or chauffeur's license issued to the person so lending or permitting the use thereof;
- (C) Display, or represent as one's own, any operator's or chauffeur's license not issued to the person so displaying the same;
- (D) Fail to surrender to the registrar of motor vehicles, upon his demand, any operator's or chauffeur's license which has been suspended, canceled, or revoked;
- (E) Use a false or fictitious name, or give a false or fictitious address, in any application for an operator's or chauffeur's license, or any renewal or duplicate thereof, or knowingly make a false statement, or knowingly conceal a material fact and otherwise commit a fraud, in any such application.

Section 2. Whoever violates Section 1. of the foregoing ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined not more than \$50.00, together with the costs of prosecution.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
