

ORDINANCE NO 5 -59

To provide for the purchase of a motor-driven street sweeper, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Auditor be, and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of one self-propelled gasoline engine driven street sweeper, equipped with brushes and gutter broom, water tank and water spray, lights and turn indicators, and such other equipment as may be necessary to make it a complete self-contained unit.

Section 2. Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law. The sum of \$ 11,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Street Construction Maintenance & Repair Fund and the sum of \$ xxx is hereby appropriated from the xxx Fund for the purposes aforesaid.

Section 3. This Ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the City streets are badly in need of street sweeping for health and safety reasons, and said Ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
