

ORDINANCE No. 9 -59

To amend Section 62 of Ordinance No. 30-51, being an ordinance to establish a traffic code for the City of Bexley, Ohio, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That paragraph (b) of Section 62 of Ordinance No. 30-51 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

(b) All streets intersecting Columbus Avenue, from the north line of Bryden Road to the north corporation line, except where Columbia Avenue intersects through highways, Maryland Avenue and Ruhl Avenue;

Section 2. That existing paragraph (b) of Section 62 of Ordinance No. 30-51 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the traffic is so dangerous that immediate action needs to be taken to correct it and said amended ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
