

ORDINANCE NO. 20 -66

To prohibit unusually rapid acceleration of motor vehicles.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to operate any motor vehicle in such manner that the engine is so rapidly accelerated or started from a stopped position, that the tires of such vehicle squeal or leave tire marks on the roadway, which practice is commonly referred to as "peeling".

Section 2. Any person who violates this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$50.00.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
