

ORDINANCE NO. 10-67

To revise the payroll schedule of the Bexley Police Department, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That effective April 1, 1967, the payroll schedule for the Police Department shall be as follows:

Patrolmen:

First year of employment by Bexley	\$491.00 per month
Second year of employment by Bexley	499.00 per month
Third year of employment by Bexley	515.00 per month
Fourth year of employment by Bexley	540.00 per month
Fifth to tenth year of employment by Bexley	565.00 per month
Tenth to twentieth year of employment by Bexley	590.00 per month
Twentieth year and thereafter	615.00 per month

Sergeant: \$90.00 per month

Chief: 765.00 per month

Section 2. That effective April 1, 1967, Blue Cross comprehensive coverage and Blue Shield preferred coverage shall be furnished free of charge to all members of the Police Department for themselves, their wives and unmarried children under 19 years of age residing at home.

Section 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith be repealed, and this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that less than thirty (30) days remain before April 1, 1967, and this Ordinance shall go into force and effect upon passage thereof and approval by the Mayor.
