

ORDINANCE NO. 18 -68

To relieve the city from any damage caused by removal or storage of a vehicle.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY,  
STATE OF OHIO:

OR BY ORDER OF A POLICE OFFICER

Section 1. The removal by a police officer of a vehicle, in accordance with any of the ordinances of the City of Bexley shall be at the risk of the owner or person in charge thereof, and there shall be no liability on the part of the City for any damage caused by such removal.

Section 2. The storage of any vehicle, when impounded by the City, shall be at the risk of the driver or owner thereof, and the City shall not be liable for damage of any nature or the theft or destruction by fire, of any vehicle so impounded.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
