

ORDINANCE NO. 36 -68

To amend Ordinance No. 29-68 and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 29-68 is hereby amended by deleting the provision requiring that 1966 Ford four-door Sedan, Serial No. 6W54B141421 be traded in, and the Mayor and the Auditor be, and they hereby are authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of the four-door sedan authorized in said ordinance without such tradein.

Section 2. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the said Police Department is in need of said motor vehicle for patrol duty, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
