

ORDINANCE NO. 47 -68

To provide for retirement of members of the Police Department.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That effective July 1, 1969, no member of the Police Department of the City of Bexley shall continue in such service after attaining the age of sixty-five (65) years. Each member shall, upon attaining such age, be retired with such pension rights as may be provided by law and the rules of the Police Pension Fund. If the Mayor believes it to be in the interest of the city to retain any such member in such service after attaining the age of sixty-five (65) years, he may do so for such a period or periods as he may from time to time determine, but not beyond the date when such member attains the age of sixty-six (66).

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
