

RESOLUTION NO. 6 -69

Declaring it necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation.

WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount necessary for the requirements of said city of Bexley, Franklin County, Ohio; therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Bexley, Franklin County, Ohio, two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring, that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of the City of Bexley, Ohio, for the purpose of current expenses, at a rate not exceeding three (3) mills for each One (\$1.00) Dollar of valuation, which amounts to No dollars and thirty cents (\$.30) for each One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars of valuation, for five (5) years, and which levy is a renewal of an existing levy of three (3) mills.

RESOLVED, that said levy be placed upon the tax list of the current year after the February settlement next succeeding the election, if a majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Clerk of this Council of the city of Bexley be and he is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Board of Elections, Franklin County, Ohio, prior to the 15th day of September, 1969, and notify said Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.
