

ORDINANCE NO. 7-69

To establish a petty cash fund for the Recreation Director, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Auditor be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to establish a petty cash fund of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for the use of the Recreation Director in paying small bills of the Recreation Department.

Section 2. That the responsibility of safeguarding and properly disbursing the money in said petty cash fund is hereby placed on the Recreation Director.

Section 3. That this ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety in the daily operation of the various city departments, and the same shall go into full force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
