

ORDINANCE NO. 2 -71

Providing for the purchase of a 3 wheel refuse dump vehicle for the use of the Refuse Collection Department, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Auditor be and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of one new 3 wheel refuse dump vehicle with air cooled gasoline engine, 4 cycle, automotive steering, automotive-type transmission and hydraulic operated dump body, the other specifications for which are as follows:

Engine Specifications: 2 cylinder; 4 cycle; minimum of 17.6 H.P. @3600 RPM; 12 volt electric starter with heavy duty 35 amp alternator.

Drive: Automotive $6\frac{1}{2}$ " clutch.

Transmission: Automotive type with 3 speeds forward and one reverse. Standard 'H' Pattern with shift lever on steering column.

Brakes: Heavy duty hydraulic.

Controls: Splash shield under floorboard to protect controls from road splash.

Tires: 5.00/5.70 x 8 4-ply tires, X-tra Grip tread on rear.

Dump Body: Steel construction with minimum hopper capacity of 2 cubic yards.

Cab & Accessories: All weather cab with electric windshield wiper, back rest on seat, self cancelling turn signals with emergency flasher, speedometer, front bumper, sealed beam headlight with dimmer switch on floor, fuel gauge, ammeter, oil pressure warning light, horn, key starter switch, rear and sideview mirrors.

Color: White

Section 2. That the Mayor and the Auditor be and they are hereby authorized to enter into a three year lease for a 3 wheel refuse dump vehicle as described in Section 1 hereof, at the option of the Mayor and the Auditor in lieu of the purchase of the same.

Section 3. Said contract or lease shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law. The sum of \$3,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the purpose aforesaid.

Section 4. This ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that said equipment is needed immediately in the operation of the Rubbish Department, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
