

ORDINANCE NO. 37 -71

To provide for the purchase of insurance, and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, none of the bids for insurance recently submitted to the City were deemed acceptable by the City, and

WHEREAS, the only solution is to readvertise for new bids, now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of insurance in accordance with the specifications and instructions which have been prepared therefor, and they are also hereby authorized to decide which alternates to accept, if any, and which coverages to delete, if any.

Section 2. That said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the existing insurance is by binder and said insurance is needed at once to properly protect the interest of the city, and this ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
