To appropriate funds.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$5,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying the City of Bexley's share of the cost of establishing a Community Relations Division in the Bexley Police Department, including the employment of a Community Relations Officer and the purchase of necessary and advisable equipment in connection therewith in order to increase public understanding, support and cooperation with law enforcement, the balance of the cost of this project to be received as a law enforcement action project grant under Part C and E of Public Law 91-644.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
