

ORDINANCE NO. 26-72

Providing for the purchase of an automobile for the use of the Community Relations Officer of the Police Department, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Auditor be and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of one new 1973 Station Wagon for the use of the Community Relations Officer of the Police Department, the specifications for which are on file in the Mayor's office, or one new 1973 4-door Sedan, the specifications for which are also on file in the Mayor's office.

Section 2. Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law. The sum of \$3,100.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the purchase aforesaid.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the Community Relations Officer has no transportation, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
