

ORDINANCE NO. 18 -74

To increase the salary of the Mayor for the term commencing January 1, 1976.

WHEREAS, the charter of the City of Bexley requires that any increases or decreases in the Mayor's salary must be by ordinance passed not less than one year prior to the commencement of the term to be affected; and

WHEREAS, in recent years the time required to effectively and adequately carry on the duties and responsibilities of Mayor has increased to the point where it is a full time job; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of this Council to recognize this development and adjust the salary of the Mayor for the term commencing January 1, 1976; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO

Section 1. That the annual salary of the Mayor is hereby increased to \$18,000.00 for the year 1976, \$18,750.00 for the year 1977, \$19,250.00 for the year 1978 and \$20,000.00 for the year 1979, same to be paid in equal monthly installments, said increase being permitted by the provisions of Section 5 of the charter giving Council the right to increase or decrease the salary providing the ordinance is passed not less than one year prior to the beginning of the term to be affected.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
