ORDINANCE 32 75

To make a written return to the County Auditor of the unpaid charges for weed cutting, so that the same may be entered on the tax duplicate.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of cutting noxious weeds on the property hereinafter listed, amounting in the aggregate to \$132.00 (which includes costs plus 10%) notice having been given as required by law, be and the same is hereby adopted and confirmed upon the following lots and lands, to-wit:

Section 2. That as provided in Section 731.54 of the Revised Code of Ohio, said assessment shall be certified by the Clerk of this Council to the County Auditor, to be placed by him on the tax duplicate and collected as other taxes are collected.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
