

ORDINANCE NO: 24 -76

To authorize the Mayor to appoint an advisor and probation control officer for alcohol related cases arising in Mayor's Court and appropriating funds and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY,  
STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That the Mayor is authorized to appoint an advisor and probation control officer for alcohol related cases arising in Mayor's Court.

Section 2: That the fee for services furnished shall not exceed One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars for each case.

Section 3: That Council has determined that these services require a person with specialized skill, knowledge, and training.

Section 4: That the sum of Twenty-four Hundred (\$2400.00) Dollars is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the payment of the above services for the balance of the year, 1976.

Section 5: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace, safety, and welfare for the reason that it is immediately necessary to put an Alcoholic Control Plan into effect and this ordinance shall go into full force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
