

ORDINANCE NO. 18 -77

To provide for the purchase and installation of a new 10-inch turbo water meter, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of a 10-inch turbo water meter and fittings, the specifications for which are on file in the Mayor's Office.

Section 2. Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 3. That the sum of Eight Thousand Dollars (\$8,000.00) is hereby appropriated from the Water Fund to cover the cost of the same and the cost of constructing a meter pit and installing said meter east of Alum Creek opposite the location of the present Holtzman-Payne meter.

Section 4. That this is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the present meter needs replacing as soon as possible, and this ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
