


ORDINANCE NO. 22-78

Authorizing the negotiation of a contract for resurfacing the parking lot adjacent to the swimming pool, with asphaltic concrete, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO.

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into a contract for resurfacing the parking lot adjacent to and West of the swimming pool, said resurfacing to consist of asphaltic concrete and such other specifications as have been prepared and are on file in the office of the Mayor, the total cost of the same not to exceed Twenty Thousand (\$20,000.00) Dollars.



Section 2. That said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 3. That the sum of Twenty Thousand (\$20,000.00) Dollars is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund to pay the cost of the same.



That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that said resurfacing needs to be completed before the pool opens on May 27, 1978, and this ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
