

ORDINANCE NO. 34 -78

To authorize the Mayor and the Auditor to enter into a contract for the purchase of a used motor vehicle for the use of the Director of Recreation, to appropriate funds and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, The Director of Recreation has immediate need for the use of a motor vehicle in order to properly supervise and operate his department in order to preserve the interests of the City; and

WHEREAS, competitive bidding requirements could not be met because this Council instructed the Mayor to locate a used car for the Director; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Director were offered an acceptable used 1977 Nova four door sedan for \$4,000.00 if a prompt decision was made; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Auditor are authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of a 1977 six cylinder Nova sedan, Serial No. 1X69D7W199480, from Jack Maxton Chevrolet, Inc., for \$4,000.00.

Section 2. That the sum of \$4,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purchase of the same.

Section 3. That this ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public, peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the Director of Recreation is unable to properly supervise and operate his department without a motor vehicle, and this ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
