

ORDINANCE NO. 38 -80

An ordinance to appropriate funds for the Community Awareness Substance Abuse Program organized and sponsored by the Mayor, school officials and parent organizations in the City.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That through the leadership of the Mayor of the City of Bexley and in cooperation with school officials and parent groups, a community action program against drugs and other substance abuse has been established in the City, entitled Community Awareness Substance Abuse, or CASA;

Section 2: That the program's intention is to educate the citizens, particularly the school age, with the problems of substance abuse and that it will be necessary to finance such programs through contributions from the participating groups;

Section 3: That in order to assist in the operation of this program, the sum of \$1000.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund to be used as the City's contribution to this educational effort and to be paid to the Community Awareness Substance Abuse Program;

Section 4: That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
