WHEREAS, Resolution No 4-81 was adopted by the Council of the City of Bexley, Ohio on April 28, 1981, which Resolution extended full wage and salary benefits to Officer Richard Criner for 30 days from April 19, 1981 to May 19, 1981;

WHEREAS, said Resolution further provided that Council would review the disability situation at the end of the 30 day period and the status of Officer Criner's pension application to determine further action by Council;

WHEREAS, Council has been advised that all applications for Officer Criner's disability retirement and all necessary information has been supplied to the Police and Fire Pension Board and that Officer Criner's application is now officially pending before the said Board which has advised that it will probably be approved;

WHEREAS, Officer Criner has now requested another 30 day extension of full wage and salary benefits pending action by the Board on his pension;

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, By The Council of The City of Bexley, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That this Council, pursuant to the authority provided in Ordinance 40B-50, extend full wage and salary benefits to Officer Richard Criner for a period of 30 days commencing on May 20, 1981 on the condition that said Officer immediately submit his resignation from The Bexley Police Department in writing to the Safety Director, City of Bexley, to be effective on June 19, 1981, the date that his wage and salary benefits, as extended by this Resolution will expire.
