

RESOLUTION NO. 9-81

RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO LEVY A TAX
IN EXCESS OF THE TEN MILL LIMITATION

The Council of the City of Bexley, Franklin County, Ohio, met in regular session on the 28th day of July, 1981 at the Bexley City Hall, with the following members present: Messrs. John Offenber, James Gross, John Page, John Loehnert, William Bellamy and Mrs. Carolyn Wood-Christy.

Mr. Loehnert moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, the amount of taxes that may be raised by levy at the maximum rate authorized by law without a vote of the electors will be insufficient and declaring the necessity of a levy in excess of such rate.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO, TWO-THIRDS OF ALL MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING:

Section 1: That the amount of taxes that may be raised by the levy of taxes within the ten mill limitation on the taxable property in the City of Bexley, Ohio, will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of said City;

Section 2: That it is necessary for the purpose of providing additional funds for current expenses of said City to levy a tax in excess of such ten mill limitation, at an increase in rate, not exceeding 3.0 mills for each one dollar of tax valuation of the taxable property within the City of Bexley which amounts to \$.30 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five (5) years;


Section 3: That the question of levying the additional taxes be submitted to the electors of said City of Bexley at the next succeeding General Election in November 1981 and that said levy be placed upon the tax list or duplicate of the current year if a majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof;

Section 4: That the Clerk of Council be and he is hereby, directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Board of Elections of Franklin County, Ohio, before 4:00 P.M., August 20, 1981, in order that said Board of Elections may make the necessary arrangements for the submission of such question to the electors of said City of Bexley, as provided by law.

Mr. Page seconded the Resolution and the roll being called upon its adoption, the vote resulted as follows:


