An Ordinance to appropriate funds to pay for the costs of educational seminars for administrative employees.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY,
OHIO:

Section 1: That the sum of \$550.00 is hereby appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund, \$300.00 of which is to be used by the Service Director for the costs of attendance at the Joint Conference of the Ohio Chapter of the American Public Works Association and the street maintenance and sanitation officials in Sharonville, Ohio on May 13, 14 and 15; and \$250.00 of which is to be transferred to the Mayor's Travel Account to pay the cost of attendance by the Mayor at a Stress Management Conference in Washington, D.C. on April 13, 1981;
