

ORDINANCE NO. 33-82

An ordinance to authorize the Mayor to solicit new bids, or re-bids, for furnishing all materials and labor for the remodeling and addition to the Police Headquarters Building in accordance with the revised and amended plans and specifications prepared by Karlsberger and Associates, Inc.; to appropriate \$250,000 for the payment of the cost of the project; and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY,  
OHIO:

Section 1. That pursuant to the authority of Ordinance No. 11-82 the City has previously solicited bids for the remodeling and construction of the Police Headquarters Building; that the bids which were received were substantially in excess of the projected costs; and that all such bids were rejected by the Board of Control.

Section 2. That subsequent to such bids the plans and specification for the project have been carefully reviewed by representatives of the City who have revised and amended such plans and specification in accordance with the desired anticipated expenditures.

Section 3. That this Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to solicit new bids, or re-bids, for the remodeling and addition to the Police Headquarters Building pursuant to the Charter of the City of Bexley and the applicable state law, and that such solicitation conform to the revised and amended plans and specifications, as provided by the architects, and the requirements, instructions, supplementary instructions and forms set forth in the Project Manual.

Section 4. That the sum of \$250,000 be, and it is, hereby set aside and appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund to be used for the costs of construction of this project, or the payment of any contract entered into upon acceptance of any bid for the furnishing of labor and materials for this project.

Section 5. This Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and this Ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
