

ORDINANCE NO. 37 -82

An Ordinance to appropriate the sum of \$5,184.00 for reimbursable expenses incurred by Karlsberger and Associates, Inc., for their work on the Police Department Renovation Project, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That Ordinance No. 25-81 authorized the Mayor and Auditor to enter into a contract with Karlsberger and Associates, Inc., for professional services as architects for the Police Department Renovation Project which provided for a fee of \$27,500.00 for basic services and an unspecified amount for reimbursable expenses.

Section 2: That the architect has now billed the City for \$5,184.00 as reimbursable expenses for reproduction services for the printing of the Project Manuals and that this amount will be the only additional expense outside of the basic services contract.

Section 3: That, therefore, the sum of \$5,184.00 is hereby appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying the total amount of reimbursable expenses to Karlsberger and Associates, Inc., for their work on the Police Department Renovation Project.

Section 4: That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and this Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
