

ORDINANCE NO. 50 -83

An Ordinance to amend Ordinance 2-83 and others by adding a new water meter reader position to the staff of the Water Department; to appropriate funds for salary purposes; and to declare an emergency

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY,  
OHIO:

Section 1. That the Water Department of the City of Bexley is hereby authorized to hire one (1) additional water meter reader to the number of employees now so employed by the Department, that the number of permanent positions within said Department are so increased, and that said position shall be filled in accordance with appropriate Civil Services rules and regulations.

Section 2. That the position will be paid in accordance with the schedules set forth in Ordinance 2-83 for Water Meter Reader and that the sum of \$6,000.00 should be and it is hereby appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered Water Fund and transferred to the Water Department salary accounts to pay the costs of the new employee for the balance of fiscal year 1983.

Section 3. That all previous Ordinances of the City of Bexley regarding employees and the number of positions within the Water Department are hereby amended to reflect the addition of this new position.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of said City and shall go into effect upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
