

ORDINANCE NO. 14-83

An Ordinance to authorize the purchase of an automobile for use by the Bexley Recreation Department, to appropriate funds, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY,  
OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract for the purchase of a 1984 automobile for use by the Bexley Recreation Department, the total cost of which shall not exceed the sum of \$8,000, plus the trade-in of a 1977 Chevrolet four door Sedan. and the complete specifications for which have been prepared and are on file in the office of the Recreation Director;

Section 2. That the sum of \$8,000 is hereby appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund and transferred to the appropriate account to be used to pay the cost of said contract;

Section 3. That said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law;

Section 4. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and this Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
