

ORDINANCE NO. 25 -84

An ordinance to authorize the lease, with option to purchase, of a copier for use in the Bexley Police Department, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Auditor, on behalf of the City of Bexley, should be and they are hereby authorized to enter into a lease agreement with O'Brien Office Products, Inc., for a RICOH, Model 4060 copier, for use in the Bexley Police Department, at the rate of \$143.00 per month for the period of from May, 1984 through September, 1985, with an option to purchase and an application of a portion of the lease payment to the purchase price if that option is exercised, and with an additional option to terminate the lease at any time during the term upon 30 days notice;

Section 2. That the funds necessary for the payment of the lease obligations have already been appropriated and identified to appropriate police department accounts and that payment should be made from such accounts as the monthly obligations become due; and

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety; therefore, such Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and its approval by the Mayor.
