

ORDINANCE NO. 34-84

An ordinance to authorize the purchase of seven London Plane trees for use by the Bexley Parks Department and to appropriate funds.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract for the purchase of seven (7), three-inch diameter, London Plane trees for use by the Bexley Parks Department to replace seven trees on East Main Street that have died as a result of last winter's severe weather;

Section 2. That the sum of \$1,000.00 is hereby appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund and transferred to the appropriate account to be used to pay the cost of said purchase;

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
