

ORDINANCE NO. 47-84

An ordinance to authorize the City of Bexley to enter into an agreement with the legislative authorities of not less than a majority of the other municipal corporations and political subdivisions within Franklin County to provide an Emergency Management Agency to coordinate emergency management activities within the area of Franklin County.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY,  
OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Auditor, on behalf of the City of Bexley, should be and they are hereby directed and authorized to enter into an agreement with other municipal corporations and political subdivisions within Franklin County, a copy of which agreement is attached hereto and incorporated herein as if fully rewritten; to provide for an Emergency Management Agency (to replace the Disaster Services Agency), to perform the service of coordinating the emergency management activities of the County of Franklin, and the various subdivisions therein;

Section 2. That the City of Bexley, further agrees to comply with the terms of the agreement regarding the sharing of the costs of coordinating the emergency management activities which shall be apportioned among the participating political subdivisions, and also agrees to render mutual aid to the emergency management director and each subdivision as required.

Section 3. That a party to the agreement may terminate participation at any time upon written notice to the policy board, 90 days prior to the beginning of a calendar year, as provided in the terms of the agreement.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
