


ORDINANCE NO. 9 -86

An Ordinance to authorize the Mayor and the Auditor to reimburse the National Casualty Company in the amount of \$1,000.00.

WHEREAS, the National Casualty Company insures the City of Bexley against property claims; and,

WHEREAS, the National Casualty Company settled a claim against the City of Bexley in the amount of \$3,130.75; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Bexley's policy with the National Casualty Company is a \$1,000.00 deductible policy.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Auditor be and they hereby are authorized to reimburse the National Casualty Company in the amount of \$1,000.00.

Section 2. That the amount of \$1,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund to be used for this reimbursement.


Section 3. That this ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.


