

ORDINANCE NO. 38-86

An Ordinance to appropriate funds to pay insurance premiums and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY,  
OHIO:

Section 1: That the sum of \$35,000.00 should be, and it hereby is, appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund and transferred to the General Insurance Account for the purpose of paying the premium for the City's general liability insurance.

Section 2: That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety; and, therefore, such Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
