

ORDINANCE NO. 75 -86

An Ordinance to appropriate an additional amount of \$370.00 from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for the purchase of an Automatic Drum/Disc Lathe for use by the Municipal Service Garage; and an additional amount of \$914.65 from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for the purchase of a pick-up truck for use in the Parks Department; and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, Ordinance #4-86 appropriated \$6,000.00 for the purchase of said Automatic Drum/Disc Lathe, and \$8,727.00 for the purchase of said pick-up truck; and,

WHEREAS, the lowest and best bid received for the Automatic Drum/Disc Lathe was \$6,370.00; which exceeds the original appropriation by \$370.00, and the lowest and best bid received for the pick-up truck was \$9,641.65, which exceeds the original appropriation by \$914.65; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to accept this bid because it is unlikely a lower bid will be received if it is re-bid, and there are available funds in the Capital Improvement Fund to complete the purchase.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$1,284.65 be and the same hereby is appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purchase of an Automatic Drum/Disc Lathe and a pick-up truck in accordance with bids received by the Service Department.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the close of the 1986 fiscal year and the need to encumber funds and execute the contract before December 15, 1986, and that this Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
