

ORDINANCE NO. 1-87

An Ordinance to appropriate funds for the period beginning January 1, 1987 and ending on February 28, 1987.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY,
OHIO:

Section 1: That there is hereby appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund, Recreation Fund, Water Fund, Sewer Fund, Refuse Fund or any other designated fund, as appropriate, for each office, department, board or commission for which an appropriation was made in Ordinance No. 1-86, out of monies to the credit of the respective funds, for each specific line item for which an appropriation was made by Council for the calendar year 1986, an amount equal to one-sixth of each item's effective appropriation as of December 31, 1986, except that the amount appropriated for the purpose of paying salaries and other benefits of the bargaining unit consisting of all full-time policemen and policewomen in the rank of police officers shall be adjusted in accordance with the provisions of the collective bargaining agreement by and between the City and the Fraternal Order of Police, Capital City Lodge No. 9, with respect to said bargaining unit.

Section 2: That the City Auditor is hereby authorized to draw warrants for the payment of any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefor, approved by the officer or officers authorized by law to approve the same or an ordinance or resolution of Council to make the expenditure; provided, that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except for persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance.

Section 3: That this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date permitted by law.
