

ORDINANCE NO. 30 -87

An Ordinance to authorize the transfer of funds from the General Fund to the Swimming Pool Fund, to appropriate funds from the Swimming Pool Fund and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY,
OHIO:

Section 1: That \$22,000 is hereby transferred from the unencumbered General Fund to the Swimming Pool Fund.

Section 2: That \$22,000 is hereby appropriated and set aside from the Swimming Pool Fund for the following purposes: purchase of chairs - \$5,000, renovation to and purchase of equipment for the concessions area - \$12,000, and electrical repairs and installation - \$5,000.

Section 3: That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into contracts for the purchase of the goods and services specified above when and as necessary or desirable.

Section 4: That the contracts authorized herein, when required by law, shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 5: That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety in order to complete repairs to the pool so that it can open on Memorial Day weekend and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
