

ORDINANCE NO. 12-88

An Ordinance to permit Walter Bakle, formerly the Supervisor of Recreation, to serve as the interim Assistant Director of Recreation, effective as of February 13, 1988, to establish the salary and privileges for such position, and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, Matthew Hackett, the Assistant Director of Recreation, has resigned from such position; and,

WHEREAS, the Recreation Board of the City of Bexley has recommended, the Mayor has so appointed, and this Council has approved the appointment that Mr. Walter Bakle, the Supervisor of Recreation, be the interim Assistant Director of Recreation effective as of February 13, 1988, until such time as a replacement Assistant Director of Recreation is hired; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the salary of the position of interim Assistant Director of Recreation shall be at the rate of \$18,200.00 per year, effective as of February 13, 1988, with all other privileges and benefits of salaried positions for the City of Bexley, during the interim period.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the necessity of continuing recreation programs without interruption during the interim period, and this Ordinance shall go into full force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
