

ORDINANCE NO. 22 - 88

An Ordinance to appropriate funds to pay for the rental, delivery, set-up charges and electrical service for a self contained trailer to be used as temporary office space from April through December, 1988, during the renovation of Jeffrey Mansion, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That the sum of \$3,600.00 should be, and it hereby is, appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying the costs of rental, delivery, set-up charges and electrical service for a self contained trailer to be used as temporary office space, from April through December, 1988, during the renovation of Jeffrey Mansion.

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, in order to assure uninterrupted activities of the Recreation Department. This Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
