

ORDINANCE NO. 58 - 88

An Ordinance to authorize a variance to allow for a 43 inch high split rail fence to remain in the front yard setback area at 935 Pleasant Ridge Avenue (lot number 2, Edward Livingston Addition), premises owned by Terry A. and Ruth S. Steer.

WHEREAS, Terry A. Steer has applied for a variance to allow for a split rail fence in the front yard setback area pertaining to the property owned by him at 935 Pleasant Ridge Avenue; and,

WHEREAS, the approval of the variance would not be detrimental to the character of the surrounding residential neighborhood and complies with the requirements of Ordinance No. 42-85; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the application of Terry A. Steer, dated July 24, 1988, for a variance to authorize and approve the erection of a split rail fence in the front yard setback area as part of an overall landscaping plan of the premises at 935 Pleasant Ridge (lot number 2, Edward Livingston Addition), complies with the requirements of Ordinance No. 42-85 and it is, therefore, granted, and the location of the fence as currently existing be approved.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

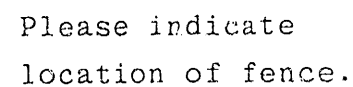
