

SUBSTITUTE ORDINANCE NO. 36 -90BY: John H. Offenberg

An Ordinance to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for the purchase of recycling bins, to authorize the transfer of funds from the General Fund to the Capital Improvements Fund, to appropriate funds from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purchase of recycling bins and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed, after advertisement according to law, to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder for the purchase of 5,000 recycling bins.

Section 2. That the sum of \$30,000.00 be, and it hereby is, transferred from the unencumbered General Fund to the Capital Improvements Fund.

Section 3. That the sum of \$30,000.00 be, and it hereby is, appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purchase of 5,000 recycling bins; said funds to be reimbursed to the General Fund through the sale of recycling bins to residents of Bexley who participate in the City recycling program.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is an emergency necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the necessity to begin a curbside/alley-side recycling program at the earliest possible time, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
