

ORDINANCE NO. 17-92BY: Richard F. Weber

An Ordinance to authorize the purchase of materials for maintenance and repair of streets for the balance of the year 1992, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed, after advertisement according to law, to enter into contracts with the lowest and best bidder for the purchase and delivery of the following materials for the maintenance and repair of the various streets and avenues in the City of Bexley, for the balance of the year 1992, to wit:


Bituminous Concrete --- 150 tons


Cement Concrete --- 350 cubic yards


Section 2. That the amount of \$26,000.00 has been appropriated and set aside from the Street Construction, Maintenance and Repair Fund, Account Number 03-380-133, in Ordinance No. 16-92 for the purchase of bituminous concrete and that said contract, as specified in Section 1, shall not exceed this amount.

Section 3. That the amount of \$15,000.00 has been appropriated and set aside from the Street Repair, Operating Supplies Fund, Account Number 03-387-132, in Ordinance No. 16-92 for the purchase of cement concrete and that the contract, as specified in Section 1, shall not exceed this amount.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and for the adequate operation of the Street Department, and this Ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
