

ORDINANCE NO. 26 -92By: John M. Brennan

An ordinance to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to enter into a contract for the purchase of term life insurance for City employees and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY,  
OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract for the purchase of term life insurance for City employees on such terms and conditions as they shall deem to be in the best interests of the City.

Section 2. That the contract authorized herein, to the extent required by law, shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 3. That this ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to provide uninterrupted life insurance coverage to City employees on the best terms available, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
