

ORDINANCE NO. 46-92By: John M. Brennan

An Ordinance to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to enter into a contract for the purchase of four police cruisers, and accessories, at a price of not more than \$70,000 for delivery and payment on or after January 1, 1993 and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of four police cruisers, and accessories, the aggregate purchase price of said cruisers and accessories to be not more than \$70,000.

Section 2. That the contract shall be conditioned upon delivery and payment of the cruisers on or after January 1, 1993, it being the intention of Council to provide for such payment from an appropriation to be enacted by it in 1993.


Section 3. That the contract authorized herein, when required by law, shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the necessity of completing arrangements for the purchase and delivery of the cruisers at the earliest practicable date in 1993, which shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.


