

Amended ORDINANCE NO. 57 -92By: Jeffrey H. McClelland

An Ordinance to transfer ~~\$25,000~~ ^{+ 33,600} from the unencumbered General Fund to the Capital Improvements Fund, to appropriate ~~\$25,000~~ ^{+ 33,600} from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of purchasing play equipment for Jeffrey Park and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That ~~\$25,000~~ ^{+ 33,600} is hereby transferred from the unencumbered General Fund to the Capital Improvements Fund.

Section 2. That ~~\$25,000~~ ^{+ 33,600} is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of purchasing outdoor play equipment for Jeffrey Park.

Section 3. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract or contracts for such purpose and that the contracts authorized hereby, when required by law, shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the necessity of providing adequate play equipment at the earliest practicable date, which shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
